The Board of Trustees of Freedom Township met on the above date. Mr. Bruning called the meeting to order. Trustees David Bruning, Kent Schuerman and Richard Rahe were present along with, Fiscal Officer, Julie Getz, Fire Chief, Duane Martin, Road Superintendent, Bob Rentz, and Ron Golightley.

Mr. Rahe moved to approve the minutes of the April 28, 2021 meeting, seconded by Mr. Schuerman, all yes, motion carried.

Bills and Payroll were presented and a motion to accept as presented was made by Mr. Schuerman, seconded by Mr. Rahe, all yes, motion carried.

Receipts were presented and reviewed. A motion was made by Mr. Rahe to accept the Receipts as presented and Mr. Schuerman seconded the motion, all yes, motion carried.

Appropriation Supplemental Report was presented and reviewed and Mr. Schuerman moved to accept the report as presented, Mr. Rahe seconded the motion, all yes, motion carried.

FUND REPORTS – Fund reports were presented and reviewed.

As soon as reports approved Mr. Bruning left the meeting. Therefore, the remaining motions will reflect accordingly.

ROADS – Mr. Rentz reported the new road mower came in last Wednesday. The new bermer is on truck. Joey Rentz will be starting full time on Monday 17th.

The catch basin at Wayne/Swan is cracked and Mr. Sieving has requested that it be fixed. It's in our right-of-way but is not currently causing a problem.

The Elmore Rd. road tile issue was fixed by Gearhart. Home owner, Dauer, agreed to pay ½ the bill and take trees down. *Mr. Rahe moved to put catch basin in front of house (Address), Mr. Schuerman seconded the motion, motion carried.*

Mr. Schuerman reported that there is a drainage issue at the corner of Eisenhower and Kahler Rd. The Board discussed the issue and *Mr. Rahe moved to have the County put in tile and extend the culvert to the East approximately 20ft. Mr. Schuerman seconded the motion, motion carried.*

CEMETERY – *Mr. Rahe moved to donate \$75 to Freedom Post 183 for Memorial Day flowers. Mr. Schuerman seconded the motion, motion carried.*

FIRE – Chief Martin reported that the Department would like to use the Worker's Comp. Grant money to purchase cancer protecting hoods and gloves (Not an Extractor).

He has arranged a Hazmat class for June 13th at station. The University of Findlay will be coming in.

On-Call issue discussed with officers. Wants Trustees to draw up a policy to allow others to cover if no medic is available to cover the time slots.

Chief Martin spoke to Jason Mitchell from Dynalite Battery about putting a battery supply in station. Batteries would be charged out when used instead of paying for stock all at once. The Board approved the request.


